

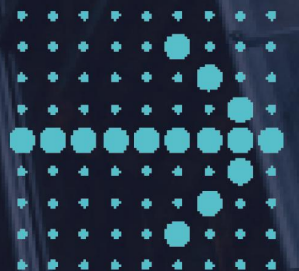

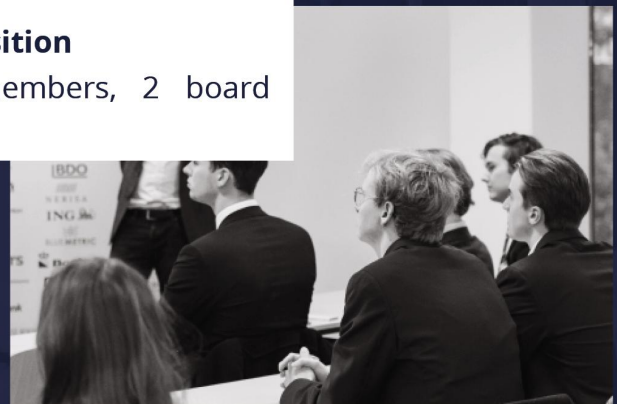

The programme consists of interactive cases and informal activities such as lunches and drinks, allowing students to experience what working as a consultant is like and connect with consultants from different firms.

Last year's participating companies were SeederDeBoer, Metyis, Boer & Croon, Roland Berger, OC&C and Bain & Company. As a committee member, you are responsible, among other things, for the following tasks:

- Coordinating the different inhouse days

INTERNATIONAL RESEARCH PROJECT COMMITTEE

The International Research Project (IRP) committee organises the largest project of FSR. As a committee member of the IRP you are responsible for selecting the participants and choosing the field research destination. The committee is divided into 3 functions, the International, Commercial and HR officer. Respectively responsible for the flights and accommodations, keeping an overview of the project acquisition and the team-building events. On top of that, you will participate in the project, which consists of two months of desk research and two weeks of field research.

Throughout the year, the group will follow trainings to prepare themselves for the project. During the project, you will put your theoretical knowledge into practice. The IRP offers you the opportunity to work at a high level in a fast-moving economy, and it provides a valuable learning experience during your studies. The IRP starts in November with different training sessions in the Netherlands.

In July, the team of 20 students travels to an international destination to provide professional consultancy services to international companies. In previous years, the project took place in Brazil and South-East Asia.

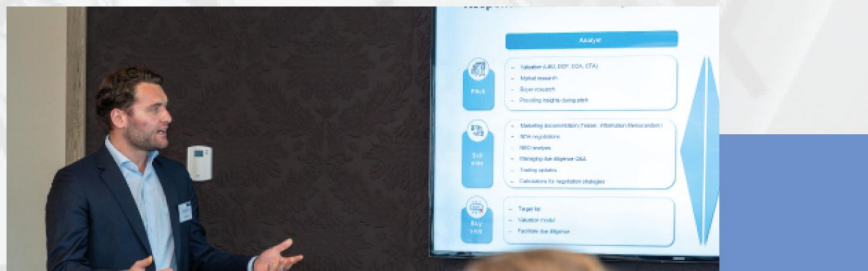
MASTERCLASS COMMITTEE

Next to recruitment events the FSR also aims to contribute to a broader education for our members. Together with partners, FSR offers (short) courses on a specific topic. This could be a training focussing on soft skills such as interview training, CV writing training, or presentation training. Moreover, the training could be sector-specific, such as the Venture Capital Masterclass that we hosted last year in collaboration with Graduate Entrepreneur! Past pieces of training included Bloomberg Masterclass, Investment Banking Simulator, Venture Capital Masterclass and CFA training.

As a committee member you are responsible, among other things, for the following tasks:

- Responsible for finding and organising interesting masterclasses
- Contacting partner
- Arrange the promotion

Furthermore, you will be in charge of organising four different masterclasses during the Career Skills course, a course specifically focusing on third-year ESE students. Our module FSR - Professional Skills in Finance is designed for students with an interest in finance. Our Career Skill centres around five key pillars within the finance industry: (i) M&A, (ii) Accountancy, (iii) Consultancy, (iv) Asset Management and (v) Debt Advisory. The aim of these masterclasses is to educate students on the hard and soft skills needed in a career in Finance.

CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

This invaluable training will be conducted by Training the Street, renowned for delivering exceptional valuation training to esteemed institutions such as Harvard and Insead. The second day of the event will feature inhouse workshops offered by financial institutions.

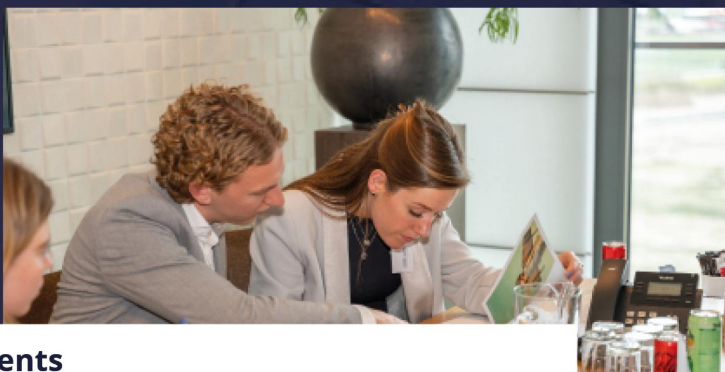
M&A/PE DAYS COMMITTEE
